

Ensuring blind peer-review

To ensure the integrity of the blind peer-review for submission to *Volcanica*, every effort should be made to prevent the identities of the **Author(s)** and **Reviewer(s)** from being known to each other.

A Title Page containing the details of the Author(s) and affiliations, as well as any acknowledgements and funding sources should be uploaded as a separate file to the blinded manuscript. To prepare the blinded manuscript, **Authors** should take the following steps regarding the manuscript and the attendant file properties:

1. Names and affiliations of the **Author(s)** of the document should be deleted from the manuscript;
2. Author information should be removed from the file or document properties, including the filename;
3. The third person should be used to refer to work that the **Author(s)** have previously undertaken (*e.g.* phrases such as “as we show in a previous contribution” should be replaced by “as previously shown by Author (2015)”);
4. **Author(s)** should ensure figures and tables do not contain any affiliation-related identifier;
5. Acknowledgements should be removed, and
6. References to funding sources should be removed.

Similarly, **Reviewer(s)** should ensure that their review file does not contain identifying information in the document properties, such as sticky notes or identifiable tracked comments.
